Arrival at Cairo International airport "Meet & Assist "

Transfer: A Longitude 180 Representative will meet you at airport

and escort you to your Cairo hotel an air-conditioned vehicle.

Check in & Overnight at The Four Seasons First Residence.



Day 02

Breakfast: buffet breakfast at hotel

Pyramids: Your Egyptologist will meet you at the hotel to escort you on an unforgettable tour of the Great Pyramids of Giza. The only present-day survivors of the Seven Wonders of the Ancient World, they are among the world's greatest tourist attractions and never lose their ability to inspire and overwhelm visitors. Your tour today includes an opportunity to enter inside one of these fabulous monuments and explore the mysteries of its ancient past for yourself.



Camel Ride: No trip to Egypt would be complete without a ride on a "ship of the desert", and so you will have an opportunity to mount your individual camel for a short ride across the sands of Giza to the Sphinx.

Sphinx: Enter the temple of the mysterious Sphinx, an ancient figure shrouded in legend and mystery. Your Egyptologist will enthrall you with the tales told of this fascinating figure.

Sakkara: Experience Egypt's long and rich history in our exciting double tour to the city of Memphis and the necropolis of Sakkara. At vast Sakkara, you will see the famous Step Pyramid of King Zoser, the first freestanding stone structure in the world. Our Egyptologist will guide you to some tombs belonging to the nobles of the past. They show the beauty and excellence of Ancient Egyptian art on their walls and give an insight in the daily life of Ancient Egypt.



Memphis: At the site of Memphis, you will see the ancient capital that once stood as a flourishing metropolis during the time of the Pharaohs. The place is thickly surrounded by lush palm groves and bushes, isolating the site of the old city from modern civilization. Return to hotel

Overnight: Overnight at Four Seasons First Residence.

Day 03

Arrival Luxor

Karnak Temple: Visit the Temple of Karnak, built over more than a thousand years by generations of Pharaohs. The great "Hypostyle Hall" is an incredible forest of giant pillars, covering an area larger than the whole of Notre Dame Cathedral.

Check-in at noon time: Arrive on your 5-star deluxe Nile cruise boat, the "Sun Boat IV", moored in a private dock in Luxor. On board, you will be welcomed by the reception staff, who will offer you chilled fruit juice while assisting with your check-in.



Entertainment: Exact entertainment schedules during your cruise are adjusted according to the needs of each group and the exact sailing schedule of the boat, and, therefore, the day of each feature is subject to change. However, every cruise on the Sun Boat IV will include:

- A colorful "galabeyya party" which gives each guest the opportunity to dress up in traditional Egyptian dress and dance to Arabic music.
- A belly dancer, accompanied by a whirling dervish show in Luxor.
- A trio of authentic Egyptian musicians in Aswan during afternoon tea.
- A lecture accompanied by a slide show, by your Egyptologist guide.

Food & Beverage: Menus are changed on a seasonal basis to enable the Chef to use the freshest ingredients at all times. However, the following is applicable to every cruise:

- Most meals are served in the restaurant. However, at least one barbecue lunch (while sailing) and breakfast will be served on deck (weather permitting).
- Afternoon tea includes a range of teas and herbal infusions, fresh coffee and a selection of freshly baked, homemade cake, cookies and finger food
- Mineral water, tea and coffee are included on a complimentary basis during meals.

Lunch: to be served on board

Valley of the Kings & Queens: Afternoon visit to the West Bank of Luxor to explore the Valley of the Kings, a vast City of the Dead where magnificent tombs were carved into the desert rocks, decorated richly, and filled with treasures for the afterlife by generations of Pharaohs. You will also have the chance to visit at least one tomb in the Valley of the Queens.



Hatshepsut Temple: Rising out of the desert plain in a series of terraces, the Temple of Queen Hatshepsut (Ancient Egypt's only female Pharaoh) merges with the sheer limestone cliffs that surround it, as if nature herself had built this extraordinary monument.



Photostop at Colossi of Memnon: On the way back to the river Nile, your road passes by the famed Colossi of Memnon, known in Ancient Greek times for their haunting voices at dawn.



Cocktail Reception: Tonight you will be greeted by your Boat Manager, who will introduce you to the boat staff and review on-board facilities and your cruise program for the next few days. Complimentary cocktail and a selection of canapés will be served.

Dinner: Gourmet menu on board.

Overnight: On board in Luxor.

Day 04:

Very early sailing to Qena

Breakfast: Breakfast buffet on board while you cruise northwards to Qena, a particularly alluring part of Upper Egypt's landscape.

Denderah: Visit the Ptolemaic Temple of Goddess Hathor in Denderah. This wonderfully preserved temple complex is a rare sight to behold, complete with a massive stone roof, dark chambers, underground passages and towering columns inscribed with hieroglyphs. The main Temple of Hathor is almost intact. Hathor was the goddess of pleasure and of love, usually represented as a cow, or a woman with a cow's head. She was the beneficent deity of maternal and family love, of beauty and light; the Greeks associated her with Aphrodite.



Lunch: Return to your boat for Lunch during sailing back to Luxor.

Afternoon Tea: Afternoon tea will be served while you cruise to Luxor.

Luxor Temple: Your Egyptologist will guide you on a tour of the East Bank of Luxor, to the strikingly graceful Temple of Luxor dedicated to the God Amun.



Dinner: Gourmet menu on board followed by a belly dancer, accompanied by a whirling dervish show.

Overnight: On board in Luxor.

Day 05:

Early sailing to Edfu passing by Esna

Breakfast: Breakfast buffet on board while you cruise to Edfu.

Edfu Temple: This morning, explore the largest and most completely preserved Pharaonic – albeit Greek-built – temple in Egypt, the extraordinary Temple of Horus at Edfu.



Lunch: Lunch on board, while you continue cruising to Edfu.

Afternoon Tea: Afternoon tea will be served while you cruise to Kom Ombo.

Cooking lesson: Egyptian cooking lesson will be presented on board.

Kom Ombo Temple: Visit the Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to the crocodile-god Sobek. The temple stands at a bend in the Nile where in ancient times sacred crocodiles basked in the sun on the riverbank.



Dinner: Tonight's dinner on board will be an "Egyptian Night" costume party for all guests, with a chance to dress up in traditional Egyptian "galabeyya". Dinner will be a lavish buffet of Egyptian specialities, followed by oriental music and dancing for everyone.

Overnight: On board in Kom Ombo.

Day 06:

Breakfast: Breakfast buffet on board during sailing to Aswan.

Philae Temple: Take a short motorboat ride to visit the romantic and majestic Philae Temple on the Island of Agilka.

Unfinished Obelisk: Next we proceed to the Granite Quarries, which supplied the ancient Egyptians with most of the hard stone used in pyramids and temples, and still hold a huge unfinished obelisk.



Lunch: Lunch on board.

Felucca Ride: In the afternoon proceed (weather permitting) by taking a ride on a felucca, a typical Egyptian sail boat, around Elephantine Island, Lord Kitchener's Botanical Gardens, and the Agha Khan Mausoleum (life jackets will be provided).

Afternoon tea: Enjoy your afternoon tea served in the lounge with a trio of authentic Egyptian musicians.



Dinner: Tonight's farewell dinner will be a gala dinner (jacket required), with white-gloved waiters serving gourmet cuisine.

Overnight: On board in Aswan.

Day 07:

Breakfast: Buffet breakfast on board, and check out.

Optional Excursion to Abu Simbel Temple

Transfer: Your Longitude 180 Representative will escort you to Luxor airport for your brief return

flight to Cairo.

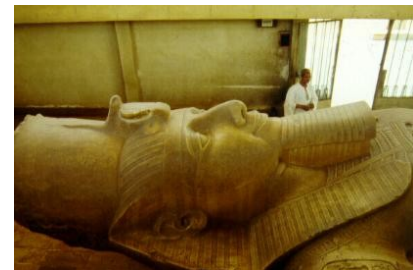
Arrival Cairo domestic airport & transfer to your hotel

Day 08:

Breakfast: buffet breakfast at hotel

Museum: Your Egyptologist will escort you today on a fascinating tour of 7,000 years of Egyptian history with a visit to the Egyptian Museum of Antiquities. The Museum houses the world's greatest collection of Ancient Egyptian artifacts, including 12 rooms filled with golden treasures from the world-famous tomb of the boy-king Tutenkhamun.



Coptic Cairo: Your Egyptologist will guide you today round the highlights of Coptic Cairo. There you will find the remains of the old Fortress of Babylon, built at the time of the Romans in Egypt to protect the country from invading enemies.

Churches: The walls of the fortress enclose the Church of St. Sergius, which is built on a crypt considered to be one of the resting places of the Holy Family during their flight to Egypt 200 years ago. You will also see the "Hanging Church", supported by only one column, and boasting incredible paintings inside.



Synagogue of Ben Ezra: Visit the Synagogue of Ben Ezra, from the time of the once thriving Jewish community in Egypt under the leadership of Rabbi Ben Ezra. Inside were discovered the so-called "Geniza Documents", which showed an unparalleled source of information about life of the Jews in Egypt's past.

Coptic Museum: You will also enter the Coptic Museum, which displays a wonderful collection of medieval statues, bells, bone carvings, frescoes, icons and colorful textiles.

Islamic Cairo: Take a fascinating tour of Islamic Cairo, including the beautiful and graceful Mohamed Ali Mosque and the ancient Citadel, a spectacular medieval fortress perched on a hill above the city. Originally built by Salah El-Din in 1176 to fortify the city against the Crusaders, the Citadel was modified and enlarged over the centuries by subsequent rulers and today is a complex of three mosques and four museums.

Return to Hotel for overnight at Four Seasons the First Residence.

Day 9

Breakfast: buffet breakfast at hotel

Check out & transfer to Cairo International airport for your departure flight back home

Important notes: -

- 1** - All prices are quoted in US\$ net & non-commissionable
- 2** – All prices are per person in double sharing with single supplement.
- 3** – Space at different properties is not booked yet & will be subject to availability upon receiving your request.
- 4** – Above please find our detailed itinerary outlining our suggested itinerary, appreciate reviewing & advising us with your comments to adjust where needed.
- 5** – Please note that above rates are valid during the mentioned periods and after which rates may be subject to revision.
- 6** - Above mentioned rates are subject to change in case of Governmental increase for taxes, services charges, entrance fees...etc
- 7** - I would recommend to have a throughout Egyptologist for groups more than 14 pax to guarantee excellent service for your guests. Extra cost can be determined case by case according to traveling period.

Payment policy:

- 1- Deposit of 30% of total package excluding airfare to be sent upon receiving a confirmation on Cabins from Longitude 180 Egypt.
- 2- Balance to be forwarded one month prior to the passengers' arrival.

Cancellation policy:

- Up to 40 days prior to arrival – No cancellation penalties will be applied
- Between 40 – 25 days prior to arrival – 25 % of the total due will be levied
- Between 24 – 14 days prior to arrival – 50 % of the total due will be levied
- Between 14 days and day of arrival – Full cancellation fees will be applied

In case of force major such as State Advisory warning against travel to Egypt, terrorist event, coup D'etat, car, or political unrest, Longitude 180 Egypt will not apply above cancellation policy but only a management fees which is cad \$ 150.00 per person.
